Why To Define Your Use Case

This brief exercise helps clarify use case ideas by identifying the benefiting department or business unit, the proposed solution, target users, and the business challenges addressed.

A well-defined use case helps the team evaluate ideas more effectively.


The "Use Case Definition" is especially useful after analyzing business challenges and gathering and discussing solution ideas.





When To Define Your Use Case

This activity takes place during the Explore phase, before starting with an innovation project. It's best to conduct this activity after gathering business challenges and generating and discussing various solution ideas.
