Why To Synthesize the User Interviews

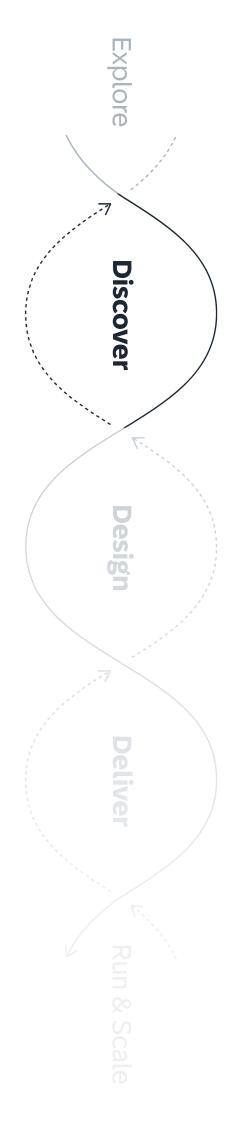
Translate thoughts and experiences into tangible, visual pieces of information.

Inspire the team to move toward identifying meaningful needs of people and insights.





When To Synthesize the User Interviews

We use this activity to synthesize the user interviews with the help of visual artifacts and storytelling during the Discover Phase. Synthesizing research is critical to generate actionable insights for the Design Phase.



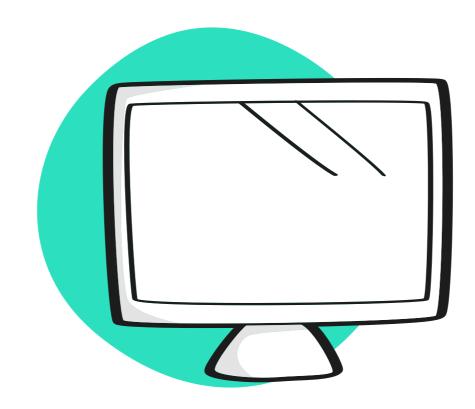


Example Synthesis Grid
